This campus features a classroom, design stage, facial room and manicure/pedicure area. We display large screen TV's for presentations and a runway for stage work. We will encourage students to enjoy the "art" of being on stage! We offer a Café menu to students and guests and also have a large patio for breaks. We have ample space for students to feel comfortable and to perform like a professional. YAI YAI Academy the art of hairdressing & modeling is a fun environment that inspires the "creativity" in you!

RESERVED RIGHTS

YAI YAI ACADEMY the art of hairdressing & modeling reserves the right to make changes in policies, procedures, schedules and other provisions in this catalog in order to enhance the quality of our education and the effectiveness of our Academy. Students will be given notifications of any policy change. All future tuition fees are subject to change.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Refunds for student withdrawals, termination or cancelation, will be handled on an individual basis with the YAI YAI ACADEMY the art of hairdressing & modeling Administration Department.

Should a student's enrollment be terminated or canceled for any reason, all refunds will be made according to the following schedule:

- Cancellations can be made in person, by electronic mail, by Certified Mail or by school termination.
- All monies will be refunded if the school does not accept the applicant or if the student cancels within three (3) business days of signing the enrollment agreement and making initial payment.
- Cancellation after the third (3rd) business day, but before the first class, will result in a refund of all monies paid, with the exception of the registration fee (not to exceed \$150.00)
- Cancellation after attendance has begun, but prior to 40% completion of the program, will result in a pro-rata refund computed on the number of hours completed to the total program hours.
- Cancellation after completing 40% of the program will result in no refund.
- When calculating the refund due to the student, the termination date is the last day of actual attendance by the student and will be used in the calculation unless earlier written notice was received.
- Refunds will be made within 30 days after termination of the student's enrollment, upon receipt of a cancellation notice from the student.

NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

This academy prohibits discrimination against current or prospective students and employees on the basis of race, color, sex, religion, ethnic origin, age, disability, sexual orientation, or any other legally protected characteristic.

HANDICAP POLICY

YAI YAI ACADEMY the art of hairdressing & modeling complies with all provisions of *Section 504* of the **Rehabilitation Act of 1973**, in that no qualified handicapped person by reason of the handicap will be excluded from enrolling in a program of instruction.

RELEASE OF INFORMATION

- Guarantee each student (or parent or guardian if the student is a dependent minor) access to that student's records
- Require written consent from the student or guardian for release of records in response to each third party request unless otherwise required by law
- Before publishing "directory information" such as: name, address and phone number of student, date and place of birth, major field of study, dates of attendance, degrees and awards received, date of graduation, previous school attended, and/or date of graduation from previous school, allow the student or guardian to deny authority to publish one or more of these items

- Provide and permit access to student and other school records as required for any accreditation process initiated by the institution or by the National Accrediting Commission of Cosmetology Arts and Sciences, or in response to a directive of the Commission.

Privacy Act – Neither the Privacy Act of 1975 nor the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (also called the Buckley Amendment) are to prohibit an accrediting agency and or its representative from inspecting student records relating to admission, financial aid, or enrollment. Also an accrediting agency, or legal representative may have access to these recorded in connection with the audits and evolution of educational programs for the purpose of enforcement of or compliance with federal legal requirements related to these programs.

This does not limit the educational agency from disclosing student records without consent of the disclosure in connection with the receipt of or application for financial aid to state, local or federal agencies. Both Privacy Acts do protect parents, legal guardians and student records from improper disclosure by the institution.

Any disclosure of student records to any person other than those mentioned above require the written consent from the student who is of legal age or their parent(s) or guardian(s).

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Absences - Students are allowed two unexcused absences per calendar month.

Excused Absences are:

- An illness with a doctor’s note
- A child’s illness with a doctor’s note
- Court with proper documentation

Make-up Policy - All students are expected to attend their schedule that is issued upon registration. If for any reason a student needs to be excused from their “pre-registered” class schedule the student is responsible to make arrangements with their instructor to make-up the missed time.

Leave of Absences – Leave of absences are granted for extenuating circumstances only and must be approved in advance by the Director. Students must request a leave of absence form from the administrative department. This form must be signed by the student and the director/administrative department to be valid. Leave of absences cannot exceed thirty (30) days and are only for extenuating circumstances. Any applicable LOA may extend the student’s contract period and maximum time frame by the same number of days as are on the LOA.

Withdraws – In the event that a student withdraws and later re-enrolls, he/she will again be required to meet the minimum requirements in each evaluation period.

GRADING POLICY

The following factors will be measured to determine academic progress: Theory Tests or Outlines, Workbooks, Practical Exams, Clinic Work, Graded Assignments, Projects. The minimum acceptable grade for any theory is 75%. All practical skills are graded on a pass/fail system. Anyone with a score below 75% must bring the score up before being allowed to graduate. **A clock hour is defined as a minimum of 50 minutes supervised or directed instruction and appropriate breaks.**

Student Grievance Policy –“Academic Grievance” means any student complaint regarding instruction, grading or academic activity that adversely affects the student’s record, academic performance or participation in academic programs.

If for any reason a student feels they are experiencing “academic grievance” they are to contact the administrative department for assistance in this matter.

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS

In order to be considered “passing” or making satisfactory progress toward a diploma, a student must maintain a specified grade average as well as proceed through the program at a pace leading to completion in a specified time frame. For purposes of determining Satisfactory Progress, each program is broken down into evaluation periods. Each student’s cumulative attendance and academic grade average is evaluated at the end of each period for their respective program according to the date the student is scheduled to achieve the hours: Cosmetology: 200, 400, 600, 800, 1000, 1200 and Modeling: 12 & 18

Students receive a numerical grade in both theory and practical work. Students must achieve a 75% GPA on work attempted in theory and practical to be making satisfactory progress. Students meeting the minimum GPA at each evaluation are considered to be making satisfactory progress until the next scheduled evaluation. If a student does not have a 75% GPA he/she is placed on probation and given an opportunity to re-take an exam or review work in another class. During the probation period, the student must achieve a 75% GPA. At this time, the student is still considered to be making satisfactory progress until the next scheduled evaluation. Financial aid will not be interrupted. If during the next scheduled evaluation, the student has not achieved a 75% GPA, the student will be considered to be making unsatisfactory progress and financial aid benefits will be interrupted. Financial Aid will be re-instated upon the student making satisfactory progress at the next scheduled evaluation. Any applicable LOA may extend the student’s contract period and maximum time frame

by the same number of days as are in the LOA.

REQUIRED COMPLETION RATE

YAI YAI ACADEMY the art of hairdressing & modeling expects students to have an AP (attendance percentage) of at least 75% of the enrollment agreement. The maximum time for a Student to complete the course is 1.33 of the course length. If the student does not finish the course within this maximum time frame, a prorated charge for the amount of time to finish will apply.

Student must achieve a 75% AP (attendance percentage) of scheduled attendance to be making satisfactory progress. Students meeting the minimum requirements for attendance at each evaluation are considered to be making satisfactory progress until the next scheduled evaluation. If a student has not made 75% AP, he/she is placed on probation. During the probation period, the student must attend 75% of scheduled attendance to be considered to be making satisfactory progress until the next scheduled evaluation, if the student has not achieved a 75% AP, the student will be considered to be making unsatisfactory progress.

RE-ENTER/RE-ESTABLISH

A student whose program is interrupted due to unsatisfactory progress and who wished to re-enter may request so after 30 days. At this time, the student will be counseled by an appointed administrator, after which a decision will be made regarding the students re-entry to school. A student who is permitted to re-enter must be re-instated in the same progress category they were in when they left and must maintain academic and attendance satisfactory progress. A student whose program is interrupted due to excused circumstances and was making satisfactory progress when interrupted, may re-enter with satisfactory progress. A student will re-enter school in the same status they left with. Students receiving financial aid will not be disbursed funds until hours previously paid for have been completed with a minimum grade average of 75%.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to graduate, a student must complete theory and practical workbooks, graduation project, clinical services, pass a written theory and a written practical examination with a 75% average. Also the student must complete all financial agreements. Upon completion of all of these requirements, the student will receive a diploma from YAI YAI ACADEMY the art of hairdressing & modeling.

FINANCIAL AID – STUDENT LOAN REFERRAL

PLACEMENT/STUDENT SERVICES

This academy offers assistance with information to seek job placement and advance training. A job placement board will post opportunities of local positions. Job prep counseling is available, prior to your employment. This Academy however, does not guarantee job placement. Our administrative team is here to insure that you are off on a successful and professional journey.

STUDENT CONDUCT

This academy expects students to conduct themselves in a professional manner. As a professional, you are on stage at all times and guests see everything. As a student of YAI YAI ACADEMY the art of hairdressing & modeling, you have a responsibility to follow the guidelines set for professional conduct. If you violate the student rules; this will give our administrative team grounds for dismissal.

- Adhere to attendance policy
- Must work as a TEAM respecting all students and staff members around you
- Must abide by the State Board Regulations
- Must abide by the student parking space provided to you
- Must respectfully represent YAI YAI Academy the art of hairdressing & modeling with a professional image and behavior
- Must be prepared for class with all supplies
- May not leave the school without permission
- Must complete assignments
- Must stay with guest during a chemical service
- Must be at your station performing services or doing book work at all times
- Any equipment left at school will be placed in lost and found
- Absolutely no beepers or cell phones in class or design stage
- Absolutely no sales of any kind on the property of the school
- Any photos taken must be approved by staff member
- Absolutely will not be allowed to attend class if tuition is unpaid
- This Academy is not responsible for any personal property of the student
- Absolutely no discriminatory displays of actions or words towards any other student
- Absolutely no verbalized disparaging or disrespectful remarks to any student or staff member
- Absolutely no smoking inside/outside by doors, only in designated outdoor areas as posted
- Absolutely no malicious destruction to school property (criminal charges may be filed)
- Absolutely no illegal drugs, alcohol or tobacco products to be used on school property
- Absolutely no cheating on exams nor providing of false information
- Absolutely no behavior that is legally defined by the government as sexual harassment
- Absolutely no weapons

APPEAL OF ACADEMIC OR DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

To appeal academic or disciplinary actions, student is present a written statement to the academy's administrative department for an appointment of review. Please be concise with your explanation, as your actions have been documented.

A student whose program is interrupted due to unsatisfactory progress and who wishes to re-enter may request so after 30 days.

TRANSFER OF CREDITS

Transfer of credits earned from this academy is determined by the receiving institution.

Transfer of credits earned from another academy to this academy is determined by YAI YAI Academy the art of hairdressing & modeling.

It is the student's responsibility to insure that proper documentation is presented to this academy's administration department.

Evaluation Fee: \$100

The evaluation fee covers the document processing as well as a skill evaluation for the enrolling student. Previous hours and services will be transferred to this academy, if appropriate. The transfer of hours will be credited to our academy, as "clock" hours. This is described as 50 minutes of supervised or direct supervision, which allows appropriate breaks. Your tuition will be pro-rated accordingly. The student must complete a minimum of 25% of their clock hours at this academy. Student will be required to pass a skills test to insure the student's academic level. The grading scale for this academy will apply.

PROGRAM OUTLINE - COSMETOLOGY

Cosmetology 1200 Hours

Objective:

Our objective is to provide students with diversified, integrated theory and practical courses based on multiple sources from the common body of knowledge of cosmetology, nails and skin care. This prepares the Cosmetology students to pass a State Exam so that the students may receive a license from the State of Florida.

Description:

The course instructs the students in cosmetology practices and state law related to the profession. In addition to classroom theory, the student will perform cosmetology services.

Program Format:

Instructional methods and techniques are used in presenting the curriculum to the students. These techniques include the use of: Lesson Plans, Lesson Outlines, Visual Aids, Videos, Lecture and Demonstration Classes including role playing and evaluation of both theory and practical skills. Instructional methods may also be developed through personal experiences with field trips, guest speakers and guest artists.

Admission Requirements

Applicants must meet one of the following requirements in order to enroll:

- Have a High School Diploma, GED, or Self Certification Letter for foreign students
- Be at least 16 years old and demonstrate the ability to benefit from the training offered.
- The Academy accepts an ATB student who takes a Wonderlic examination administered by an independent agent. The academy will give the student the time and location. Once the test is given, the academy will receive the results from the independent agent and will notify the student. The minimum score required is 200 verbal / 210 quantitative. The academy accepts students who have retaken the exam administered by the independent agent. The student is not responsible to pay for the administration of the exam.

Completion Time

Course Description

- M01 To learn poise, posture and beginning runway. Introduction to make up.
- M02 Learn the basics to hair care, nail care with manicure and pedicure tips and perform make up application

- M04 Learning the many types of modeling jobs, introduction to photo posing and review of runway.
